A new library was dedicated in April of 1965 at RJ Neutra School. Part of that dedication was the burial of a time capsule. The desire was that it be opened in 50 years.


“El Gato” The Mascot in 1965

We are still trying to find out information about the school's mascot. The yearbook indicated that “El Gato” had won a color T.V. Maybe the time capsule will provide some additional information.


New Library Dedicated in 1965

In April of 1965, RJ Neutra School students, staff, and community buried a time capsule to preserve memories of their time. Mr. Harold Mason was the Principal and Mr. Jesse Clay was the Vice Principal.

In 1965 U.S. Planes started combat missions over South Vietnam. NAS Lemoore, its proud service members and their families would be called upon to defend the interests of the United States in the Vietnam War.

On April 18, 2015, the students, staff, community, and visitors of RJ Neutra School will open the time capsule and place a new time capsule in the same location that should be opened in April, 2065.
